BGCWPA is one of the largest out-of-school-time providers in the region. Every year we serve more than 5,000 kids from Allegheny County and Somerset County and soon Westmoreland and Fayette County.

We currently operate programs in 17 locations, with 5 Stand-Alone Clubhouses, 3 School-Based Clubhouses, 2 Teen Centers, and 7 in-school programs. that include preschool, before/after school, summer camp, teen mentoring, workforce development, STEAM, and sports programs.

It is our mission to activate and advance the potential of every child, and to do that, we are reducing barriers and expanding services to offer experiences for students from preschool to post graduate. We are for kids.







Summer Camp Scholarships

BGCWPA engages in quality and supportive out-of-school-time programming to uplift the lives of youth and enrich students academically, which continues and expands learning outside of the classroom. Once the traditional school year has ended, parents still need to work, so it's essential that youth have an affordable, safe and enriching place to go. The Summer of Bold Imagination Summer Camp will provide over 300 youth ages 5-13 with 9 themed weeks of engaging topics ranging from world cultures to archeology. Through evidence-based curricula, open gym time, and STEAM activities and in alignment with PA Dept. of Education standards, these programs are designed to promote gross motor skills, academic enrichment, and social-emotional learning.




Field Trip Sponsor

Parents still need to work, so it is important that youth have an affordable, safe and enriching place to go during the summer months. Summer programs follow a themed model with topics ranging from world cultures and the outdoors to robotics and space travel. During all 9-weeks of summer camp, youth will participate in educational field trips including the Carnegie Museum of Art, PNC Park, the Pittsburgh Zoo, the Carnegie Science Center, Camp Guyasuta, Frick Park, Iron City Boulders, and more. With help from partners like you, we can offer wider varieties of field trips and include more enriching summer experiences





Field Trip Transportation Sponsor

\$1,000 - \$18,000

While our stand-alone Clubhouses and school-based sites are located in high-need communities, transportation presents a barrier for youth who do not reside within walking distance of our quality programming, for families who work non-traditional hours or do not have access to a vehicle, and for youth involved in programming that requires transportation to external sites. We contract with external providers of transportation services and with your support, we can off-set these transportation costs and allocate funds towards educational field trips, summer camp programming, and scholarship funds.
